

The purpose of the ThinkLab is to provide opportunities to our students to develop their innovation, critical thinking skills, creativity, and excel technologically so as to grow as global citizens. During the workshops, students were given an overview of the technology available in the ThinkLab viz. 3-D Printing, Space Technology, Drone and Aeromodelling, Robotics, Electronics & Sensors and much more.





**Basics of a 3D printer:** Students were taught about the structure, designing, and working of 3D printers using CAD tools. They were given handson practice with designing a rocket model in 3D and working on slicing software generating GX files for the 3D Printer.



#### **Basics of Coding,**

wherein students understood the working of the Arduino Board. To enhance their understanding of this controlling board, they undertook various programs like making HELLO Code, Arduino IDE Software, etc.



#### **Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning**

Students were introduced to the world of Al(artificial intelligence) and ML (machine learning) through various hands-on projects, based on our day-to-day life. They developed projects including object detection, face expression, speech to text conversion. In addition, they have also used the human body intervention ML model and developed the flappy bird game which they have controlled and played using their nose.



**Robotics:** They were introduced to the working, application, assembling, and testing of the Robot prepared alongwith connections of smartphone control robot.

Her book 'Postbox Kashmir: Two lives in letters', traces the political history of Kashmir and rest of India through conversations between two young girls. She also conducted a workshop on journalism as a profession.



A very well-known graphic novelist and musician Nandita Basu read from her well acclaimed YA (Young Adults) novels – 'The Piano', 'A story of a friendship' and 'Rain must Fall'. She also conducted a workshop on the art of storytelling through comics



Pika Nani's engaging and intriguing way of storytelling turned our little ones into detectives. Kids enjoyed fun worksheets, puzzles solving, unraveling secret codes based on her book 'The Egghead Detective Agency'. Her workshop on 'Introduction to basic elements of a Story' she guided the children about the basic elements of the story-theme, character, setting and the plot.



Priti David is a Journalist and Education Editor at the People's Archive of Rural India (PARI). In her workshop, she explained about the journalistic style of writing and how it is different from storytelling. She also gave students tips to write like a journalist.

Her session was centered around her book 'Coming Home', the book about forced and distressed migration.



Well known visual artist Sanket Pethkar in his session took students on a creative journey where they created a quick 4 liner narrative using random words. His workshop was aimed to give the participants a gist of the process of creating Picture book content.



Rajiv Eipe is one of the finest illustrators in our country. In his book reading session, he read 'Nisha small the knot of gold', the book illustrated by him. He told children how he came up with this character, while stressing upon the character's facial expressions and personality traits. He taught them to draw rough sketches of possible interpretations. He also encouraged the young minds to keep their curiosity alive and guided them not only to draw to tell but also to ask.



Pankaj Saikia an illustrator, picture book maker and writer, enthralled the excited little children of 3 to 6 year olds with an interactive session related to his book Theatre of Ghosts, which is a mischievous story that celebrates a wonderful Bhaona folk practice of Assam. He also conducted a workshop on storytelling and how to design and frame a story character.

He encouraged young budding authors to never give up on writing and shared his personal journey of becoming a best selling author after his many initial setbacks.
