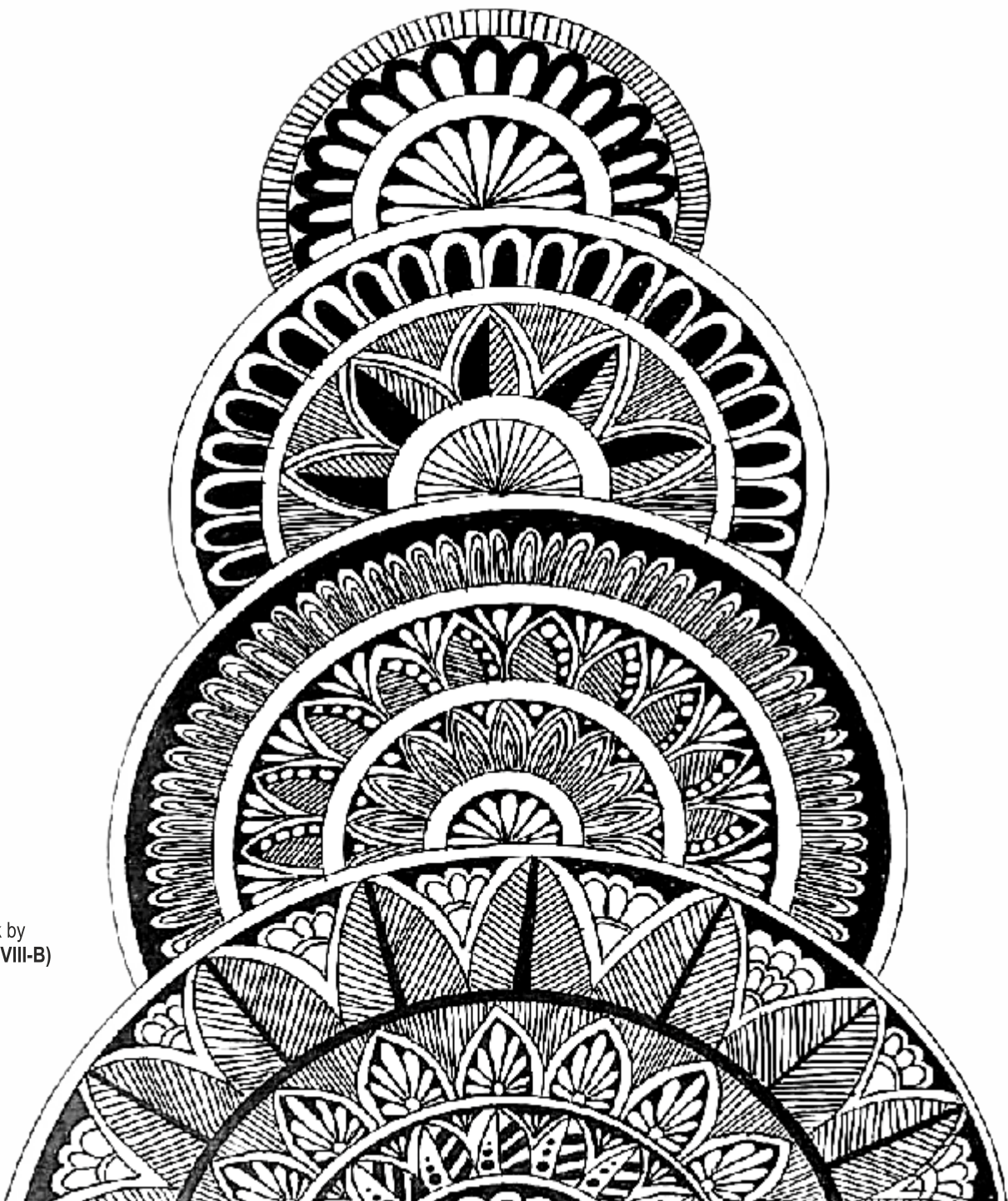

thinklab

The purpose of the ThinkLab is to provide opportunities to our students to develop their innovation, critical thinking skills, creativity, and excel technologically so as to grow as global citizens. During the workshops, students were given an overview of the technology available in the ThinkLab viz. 3-D Printing, Space Technology, Drone and Aeromodelling, Robotics, Electronics & Sensors and much more.



Basics of Electronics- The topic has been covered using hands-on project activities that included, glowing an LED, light sensor circuit, and theft alarm. They also made electronic circuits (AND gate and OR gate) and touch sensors.



Basics of a 3D printer : Students were taught about the structure, designing, and working of 3D printers using CAD tools. They were given hands-on practice with designing a rocket model in 3D and working on slicing software generating GX files for the 3D Printer.



Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning

Students were introduced to the world of AI (artificial intelligence) and ML (machine learning) through various hands-on projects, based on our day-to-day life. They developed projects including object detection, face expression, speech to text conversion. In addition, they have also used the human body intervention ML model and developed the flappy bird game which they have controlled and played using their nose.



Basics of Coding, wherein students understood the working of the Arduino Board. To enhance their understanding of this controlling board, they undertook various programs like making HELLO Code, Arduino IDE Software, etc.



Robotics : They were introduced to the working, application, assembling, and testing of the Robot prepared alongwith connections of smartphone control robot.



World Space Week 2022

World Space Week is an international celebration of science and technology, and their contribution to the betterment of the human condition. Students of Dikshant International School have developed the Model rocket during WSW 2022. They have designed and made the rocket motor, rocket body, fins, nose cone and assembled it. Students have made the launcher and ignitor system too and launched the rockets. They have studied the principle behind the rocket too.

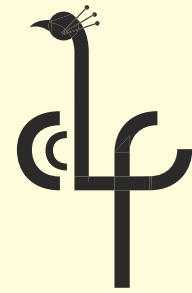

CHANDIGARH CHILDREN'S LITERATURE FESTIVAL

The 7th Edition of Chandigarh Children's Literature Festival (CCLF 2023) was organised on the 4th and 5th of February 2023 at Dikshant Global School, VIP Road, Zirakpur.

The 7th Edition of Chandigarh Children's Literature Festival (CCLF 2023) provided an excellent platform for children of 3 to 17 years of age to discover the joy of reading. Over 17 prominent children's authors, illustrators, and storytellers from diverse corners of India featured in the fest. Besides meeting their favourite authors, children also engaged in interesting interactions during story sessions, writing/illustration workshops, film screenings, to name a few.

The curator of the festival was a well-known author Ms. Chatura Rao. She writes stories for children and news articles about the goings-on in the world.

The authors covered myriad genres of literature in various sessions, which included Fictional/Fantasy, Graphic Novel, Picture Book, Mythology, Adventure, Journalistic Stories, Horror, Thriller, Historical Fiction, Non-Fiction/Biography. Moreover, it also included social issues & stories from the pandemic.



Well known documentary filmmaker and author Samina Mishra read from her award winning book 'Jamlo walks' based on what the lockdown did to the people of India, particularly its young citizens. She also conducted a film appreciation workshop for students.



The curator of the festival was a well-known author Ms. Chatura Rao. She writes stories for children and news articles about the goings-on in the world.



An award winning author and illustrator of over 25 books- Lavanya Karthik conducted an interactive workshop on different art styles and the ways they can inspire to illustrate and tell stories. During her workshop, the famous author of the Dreamer Series guided children about different illustration styles that can be used to tell a story. She explained about the famous Bhil art, Pankh art of Bhutan and miniature art style used by Mughals.



Writer / Editor Adithi Rao, who shared her love for animals to free them, as she narrated her book 'Boy,Bear'. In her workshop she explained the ways of creating and presenting the plot line that makes the story interesting.



What does it take to change the course of a nation? Reading from her book India Through People:25 Game Changers, award-winning author Devika Cariapa introduced some of the men and women who, through their vision and courage, shaped modern India. The children were prompted to think about how or what they would like to change in the world as they see it. This thought-provoking group activity was followed by a fun trivia quiz!





CANATO JIMO, the Nagaland based author illustrator, enthralled children with his book reading session on I Love Grey, where he shared the relevance of strokes in creating engaging visual stories and importance of comics in engaging early readers. His workshop ended on a sunny note of fun and cheer where kids learnt how to make a Monster in Five Steps



Children got a chance to interact with Divya Arya, who is an award-winning journalist. Her book 'Postbox Kashmir: Two lives in letters', traces the political history of Kashmir and rest of India through conversations between two young girls. She also conducted a workshop on journalism as a profession.



A very well-known graphic novelist and musician Nandita Basu read from her well acclaimed YA (Young Adults) novels – 'The Piano', 'A story of a friendship' and 'Rain must Fall'. She also conducted a workshop on the art of storytelling through comics



Pika Nani's engaging and intriguing way of storytelling turned our little ones into detectives. Kids enjoyed fun worksheets, puzzles solving, unraveling secret codes based on her book 'The Egghead Detective Agency'. Her workshop on 'Introduction to basic elements of a Story' she guided the children about the basic elements of the story- theme, character, setting and the plot.



Priti David is a Journalist and Education Editor at the People's Archive of Rural India (PARI). In her workshop, she explained about the journalistic style of writing and how it is different from storytelling. She also gave students tips to write like a journalist. Her session was centered around her book 'Coming Home', the book about forced and distressed migration.



Well known visual artist Sanket Pethkar in his session took students on a creative journey where they created a quick 4 liner narrative using random words. His workshop was aimed to give the participants a gist of the process of creating Picture book content.



Rajiv Eipe is one of the finest illustrators in our country. In his book reading session, he read 'Nisha small the knot of gold', the book illustrated by him. He told children how he came up with this character, while stressing upon the character's facial expressions and personality traits. He taught them to draw rough sketches of possible interpretations. He also encouraged the young minds to keep their curiosity alive and guided them not only to draw to tell but also to ask.



Pankaj Saikia an illustrator, picture book maker and writer, enthralled the excited little children of 3 to 6 year olds with an interactive session related to his book Theatre of Ghosts, which is a mischievous story that celebrates a wonderful Bhaona folk practice of Assam. He also conducted a workshop on storytelling and how to design and frame a story character.



The author of the national bestselling Kalki Trilogy and the Narasimha Trilogy, Kevin Missal did an interactive session on his Sinbad Series. He encouraged young budding authors to never give up on writing and shared his personal journey of becoming a best selling author after his many initial setbacks. He also guided students on how to publish and make writing a viable career



Another inspiring session at the festival was conducted by Vikram Agnihotri on his book 'Look Ma, No Hands!' The book is a biographical novel written in the style of a graphic narrative. Vikram Agnihotri is India's first double-arm amputee to get a car driving license and then become a racing driver.
