Eligible students: Kindergarten to Grade II

Kindergarten (Pre-Nursery and Nursery):

1. Drawing and Colouring
2. Finger Painting Scenes – Trees, flowers, or animals using just fingers.
3. Vegetable Print Art – Using ladyfinger, potato, or leaves for stamping patterns.

Kindergarten (LKG and UKG):

1. Finger Painting Scenes – Trees, flowers, or animals using just fingers.
2. Vegetable Print Art – Using ladyfinger, potato, or leaves for stamping patterns.
3. Sponge Dab Art
4. Tear and Paste

- Grade I:**
1. Scenes with Primary Colours- Red, Yellow & Blue only
 2. Tear & Paste Rainbow – Using coloured paper to create rainbows or shapes.

- Grade II:**
1. Scenes with Primary Colours- Red, Yellow & Blue only
 2. Nature Painting: Use dried leaves, feathers, grass, petals, twigs along with water colours to make scenes.

Rules:

- The competition will be held at school during the activity period.
- Children will be designing items based on the theme assigned class-wise.
- Entry must be original artwork created by a student rather than an idea from the internet.

Judgement Criteria- creativity, originality of thought and use of the item created where ever applicable.
