

## Spell Bee (2025-2026)

Dikshant has designed an ingenious way to impart English language skills in the form of different rounds of the Spell Bee Competition. Students, apart from learning the spellings of a vast range of words, also learn their forms, correct pronunciation, meanings, other related forms (inflections and derivations), word combinations (collocations), synonyms, antonyms, and word usage in sentences, ensuring the holistic understanding and application of the words learned.

Information about the various rounds of the competition is given below-

- **Round 1 (25<sup>th</sup> April): Written Round-** It will be the prelim round, and students will be doing a sample worksheet for the same (Details are given below). The top 5 students will qualify for the final round.
