Students, apart from learning the spellings of a vast range of words, also learn their forms, correct pronunciation, meanings, other related forms (inflections and derivations), word combinations (collocations), synonyms, antonyms, and word usage in sentences ensuring the holistic understanding and application of the words learned.

Information about the various rounds of the competition is given below-

- **Round 1 (25th April): Written Round-** It will be the prelim round, and students will be doing a sample worksheet for the same (Details are given below). The top 5 students will qualify for the final round.
