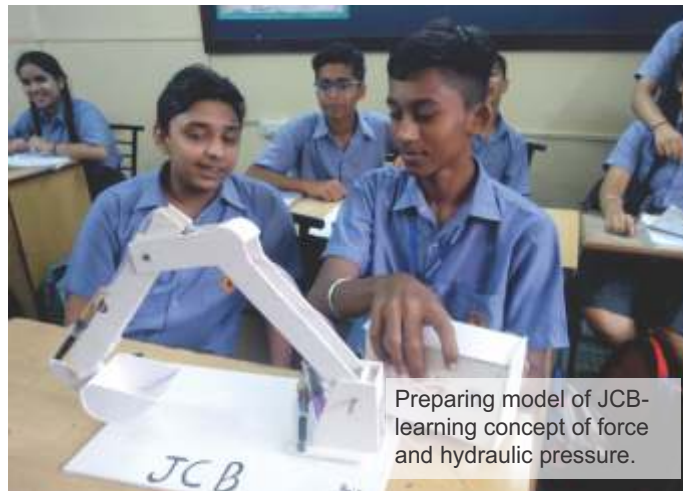

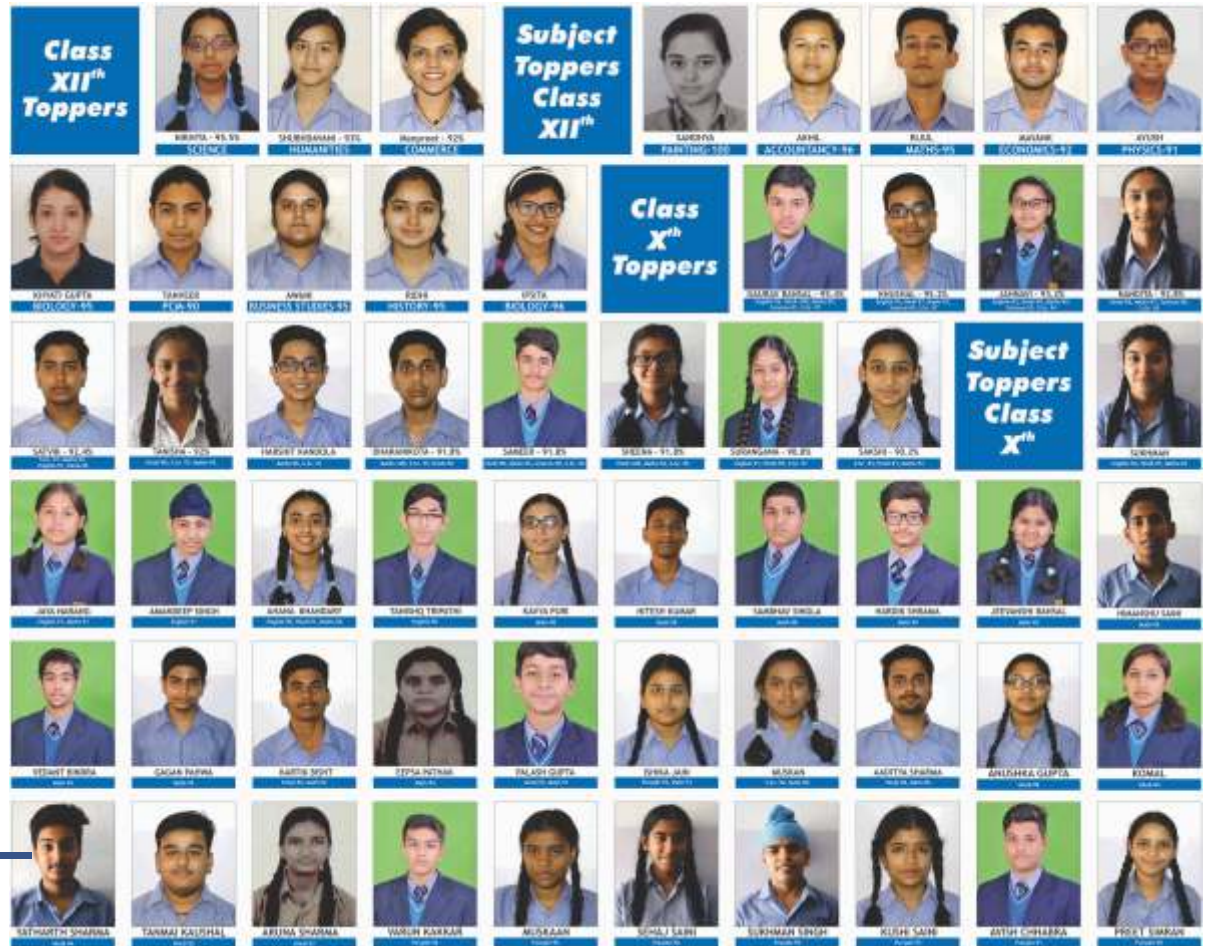

## GRADE-XII

42 students appeared in grade XII and the result is 100%. School topper is **Nikhita Rawal** who tops the Science (PCB) batch with 95.5%, **Tanveer** (90%-PCM topper), **Manpreet** (90.4%-Commerce topper) and **Shubhdayini** (92.6%- Humanities topper).

All subject wise toppers have scored exceedingly well. **Akhil Bhardwaj** topped in Accountancy with 96%, Business Studies toppers **Manpreet, Awani-95%**, **Mayank-92%** in Economics, **Manpreet-95%** (Physical Education) and **Riddhi Sood-95%** in History.
